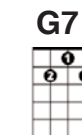
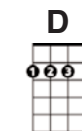
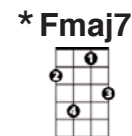
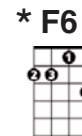
* Subsitute chords for soprano tuning:

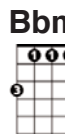
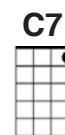
F6 substitute..... Dm 2210

Fmaj7 substitute..... 2410 keeping in the Dm position, swing your pinky to the 3rd string, 4th fret.

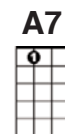
